Hell Yes Ma'am is fruity, spicy, pleasantly warming, and dangerously drinkable. This beer is bursting with elements of pear, apple, bubblegum, & pepper. Mid-palate you'll find a delicate grainy sweetness that finishes clean & spicy, warming you up as it goes down.

History of the Style

Belgian Golden Strong ales were brought into the beer-drinking public by Brewery Moortgat in Belgium (Duvel) after World War II in response to the growing popularity of the Pilsners beers of the time. Many examples carry references to the Devil or other monastic relations.
